## **NON-REGULAR CLASS DESCRIPTION:**

**Rally FAST: Off-Leash class.** Course designed using moving exercises only. No stationary exercises used. NO halts, NO stays, NO sits or downs, NO stops. Limit of 2 jumps used. A free-flowing course for experienced dogs to work on off-leash heeling and speed. Judged per Masters class.

**Rally Heeling: On-Leash class.** Course designed using moving exercises only. No stationary exercises used. NO jumps, NO sits, NO downs, NO stays, NO stops. Just a free-flowing course to work on your heeling, precision, and speed. Use verbal encouragement to get your dog excited and having fun moving with you on a loose leash! Judged per Novice class.

**All entries must be complete, including email address and required signatures, using the most recent ASCA Entry Form available at [www.asca.org](http://www.asca.org), and must be paid in full at time of entry.**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- No bitches in season will be allowed to participate in any Rally class in this trial.
- The age of all dogs will be calculated as of September 21, 2018.
- No classes will be judged prior to the posted start times on the schedule, but may be judged later.
- Day of Trial entries will be taken during armband pickup on Friday, September 21, from 5-7 pm, in the Rally Building, if runs are still available at that time.
- Armbands may be picked up during trial check-in on Friday, September 21, from 5-7 pm, in the Rally Building, and from 7:30 – 8:30 am on the day of the trial.
- Move-ups can be made via email or by US Mail to the Trial Secretary, no later than September 12, 2018.
- Cancellation of entries will be allowed through September 1, 2018; requests must be made via email or by US mail to the Trial Secretary.
- Entries will be limited to a total of 200 runs for the trial, which includes regular and non-regular classes. A notice will be posted to the ASCA Nationals website when the trial is full.
- Please refer to the 2018 ASCA Nationals Premium for directions to the trial site.
