*How it works:* Enter three dogs as a TEAM. All of the dog's scores from the six Nationals agility runs (18 scores) will be combined to calculate a

**High in Tournament, Reserve High in Tournament & 3<sup>rd</sup> place team.**

**Proceeds from entry fees and donations will go to Aussie rescue organizations ~ prizes and ribbons to the winners!**

Points will be calculated as follows: 7 points for a 10 point Q, 3.5 points for a faulted Q. If necessary, the tie-breaker for the top teams with the same number of points will be the total combined points earned in the qualifying Gamblers runs.

Each team must consist of at least two different handlers. Dogs can be competing in different levels and/or divisions but can't include dogs that have moved down to a lower level in ACE program classes (i.e. an ATCH dog that moved to ACE novice can't use novice scores).

Individual dogs may be entered on multiple teams.
